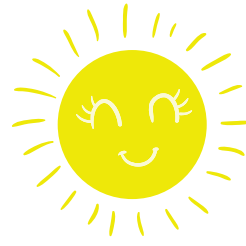


# Family Come and Play for 0-3 years

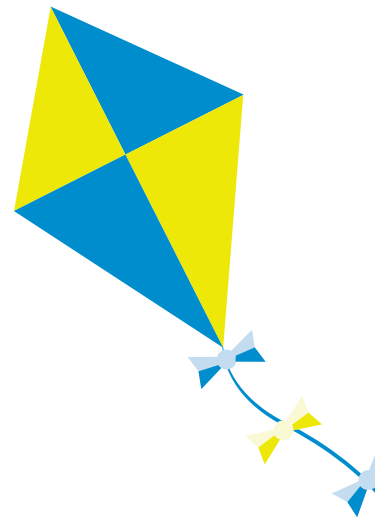
