 Warwickshire Vision Support provides Rehabilitation Services on behalf of Warwickshire County Council together with a wide range of charitable services to help people living with sight loss to retain confidence and independence.

**Rehabilitation**  
 We believe that early intervention rehabilitation can help you to more easily learn new skills, maintain your confidence and retain your social networks. We can help you to:

- Get out and about safely
- Use public transport
- Safely move around the home
- Cook and make hot drinks
- Use household appliances
- Improve communications

Normally you will be referred by your eye consultant but we can take self referrals.

**Charitable Services**  
 Our charitable services are only possible thanks to the dedication and generosity of our volunteers, donors and supporters.

**Vision Support Centres**  
 We run weekly Support Centres in Leamington, Nuneaton, Rugby, and Stratford and 'pop-up' Support Centres in North Warwickshire and more remote parts of Warwickshire. Open to all and meeting for two hours they provide access to:

- Advice and information
- Demonstration equipment
- Magnifiers
- Signposting to services
- Help 'switching' /reducing bills
- Advocacy - addressing everyday personal challenges
- Social support

**IT Training**  
 Based in our Support Centres, we provide personalised 1:1 training in the use of smart phones, tablets and laptops.
